

what is done in the 1st hour is what makes a person live or die

There are no urgent accidents

If a person falls - keep him down don't let him up. He could have

soft tissue injuries like the spleen & not even feel it. If a femoral artery goes $\frac{1}{2}$ of the blood supply can go into leg. before UC blood.

When a person is unconscious

they can still hear you refrain from saying god look at the bones sticking out of his leg, say things like, I am with you, you're not alone, help is coming keep him calm. Tell him your name & you know what to do. Do not move the person,

in case of cervical injury, leave his helmet on if he's wearing one

Call ~~and~~ 911 - it's a valuable ask for 1 ambulance per victim.

6 people pile up 6 ambulances ask to speak to the ambulance drivers. Keep talking to the victims. If he is alert ask about his name, medication he is on, health issues problem with health. Ask what they had for their last meal if they are allergic to anything while you are on the phone w/ the ambulance

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they need this info & it saves precious time.

Ask who they are
where they are
and the time of day

Try to take the pulse if you can not use the wrist use the neck

If there is someone else there write it down. ~~1/2~~ at 90 they go into shock. normal is $60-100$ per min.

Let the ambulance drivers know it was you in charge. Give as much info as you can.

Anyone else there - get the traffic out of the way & moving.
